Gippsland Youth Residential Withdrawal and Rehabilitation Program.

Located in Traralgon, Gippsland, Uniting offers a 20-bed youth focused residential withdrawal and rehabilitation program, for young people aged 16-25.


We provide:

- A safe, supportive space for young people to both withdraw from alcohol and/or other drugs and rehabilitate
- 2 dedicated withdrawal beds in our Gippsland Youth Residential Withdrawal Program (GYRWP)
- 20 beds in our Gippsland Youth Residential Rehabilitation Program (GYRRP)
- A welcoming and youth-focused facility staffed 24/7
- Group sessions, individual and group counselling and outdoor activities.

Intake process:

To begin the intake process for the young person, the following paperwork must be completed and provided:

- Youth Alcohol and Other Drug Residential- Support Agency Referral Form
- Comprehensive AOD
 Assessment
- Intake Tool
- Self-Completion Form
- Early/Safe Exit Plans.
